Herb Roasted Pork Chops & Vegetables

3/4 t Italian seasoning

1/2 t salt

1/4 t pepper

8 small new red potatoes (unpeeled and quartered)

2 C baby carrots

1 medium onion cut into 8 wedges

1 large clove garlic, finely chopped

1 T olive oil

4 boneless pork loin chops, trimmed of fat

1. Heat oven to 450 degrees F.
2. Spray 15x10x1-inch pan with cooking spray.
3. In small bowl, mix seasoning, salt, & pepper.
4. In large bowl, mix potatoes, carrots, onion, & garlic.
5. Sprinkle with oil and half of herb mixture. Toss to coat evenly. Place in center of pan.
6. Bake 20 minutes, stir vegetables.
7. Sprinkle remaining herb mixture over pork chops.
8. Place chops over and around

vegetables.

9. Bake 15-20 minutes or until pork is no longer pink and meat thermometer reads 160 degrees F; vegetables should be tender.

Prep time: 15 minutes

Start-to-finish: 55 minutes

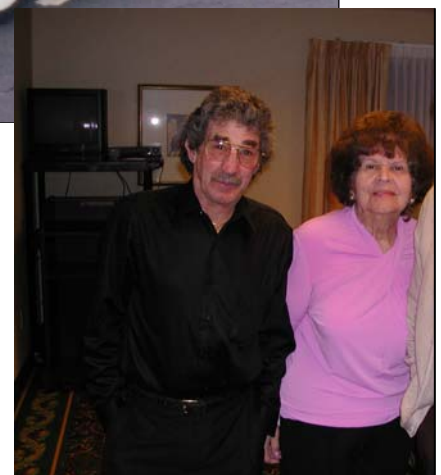

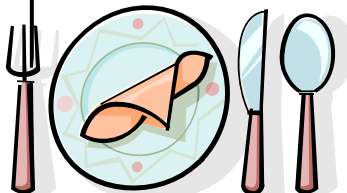
