Directions to Greenberg's show: **From Pittsburgh and points south:** Take I 80 to exit 78. Turn right at exit. Go to traffic light. Turn left at light. Go down hill to next light and turn right (Route 36 South). Go approximately one mile and the garage is on the left. **From Route 28 from Pittsburgh:** Take 28 North to Brookville. Turn right at light (322) Go down hill and right at next light to garage.

Second Stop (2 PM): The Collectacar Company in Monongahela, PA. Jim & Fran McCune, owners, have invited the CLC Pittsburgh Region to tour their garage and join the AACA Mon-Valley Region and the Early Ford V-8 club for a picnic. (Bring a chair and a covered dish, everything else will be provided.)

Directions to The Collectacar Company from Dominick's: 143 Adams St. Monongahela, PA. Take West Liberty Avenue to Route 51 South, follow to Route 43 (toll road), take exit 44. Down ramp turn left onto Rt. 136 East, past Ringgold school to "Y", go right at "Y" up hill about ¼ mile, take left onto Adams Street, follow to the end. ETA approximately 45 minutes (25 miles).

While this Garage Tour is somewhat different, it will provide an opportunity for us to view race cars in the build. Then move onto the McCune collection and join two other clubs and their cars for a picnic. As always, women are invited and their attendance is encouraged. Hope to see you on Saturday, June 19th.
